## EVENSONG PRELUDE - June 23, 2019 at 6:30 pm

Evensong Preludes showcase the many talented musicians in our parish and extended parish family while offering a time of quiet reflection before the service. Thank you to all the artists for volunteering their musical offerings.

At Evensong on the Feast of Corpus Christi, Matthew Whitfield will play Dance No. 4 for Organ by Philip Glass. This is a monumental toccata, unstoppable in its perpetual motion. Two principal ideas alternate: the first grows, modifies and corrupts on each reappearance; the second stubbornly remains the same. For 18 minutes that relationship remains stable. Then, without warning, the second idea suddenly blossoms into a stately sequence of chords, revolving around the circle of fifths with a magnificence that recalls Bach at his most monumental.

## SOUTH TRANSEPT WINDOWS

The four large stained glass windows in the south transept are being restored this summer. This is a continuation of work done in the Baptistery, funded by a grant from Heritage Toronto, and some generous donors. Until the windows are replaced in late summer, the pews in the south transept will not be available. During the removal and reinstallation there will be scaffolding erected in front of the windows. Please be careful while moving around them.
